

New Temporary Summer Policies

For the safety of our community, the Colleton County Memorial Library has enacted new temporary policies to help protect against the spread of the coronavirus.

Patrons aged 16 and under must be accompanied in the library with a parent or responsible party 17 and older until further notice.

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The Children's Room and the Teen Hideaway room are temporarily unavailable for computer access and as a gathering space until further notice. Patrons may still enter to retrieve library materials.

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Per Colleton County Government ordinance, patrons are required to wear a mask inside the library.

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Only thirty (30) patrons may be in the library building at any one time. Doors will be locked if max occupancy is reached and unlocked when patrons can enter again.

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Computer access is on a first come first serve basis with limited thirty (30) minute sessions. Additional session time subject to availability

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Computer/copier assistance from library staff is limited. Patrons that need assistance are encouraged to bring someone who can help.

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Late fees will be waived until the end of August. There may be a delay in filling hold requests due to our sanitization and quarantine procedures for all library materials.

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The library auditorium and conference room are unavailable until further notice.

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Notary services are unavailable at this time.

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No library donations, except monetary, will be accepted at this time.
